Maury, one tale that might be of great interest is that of the rescue of a satellite that wound up in low-earth orbit. Since the environment here is more damaging than at synchronous there was question whether it was worthwhile to boost it to its intended orbit. A lot of this experiment was carried out by Tom Kirkendall but, unfortunately he is no longer with us.
